## Dear friends and family, my brothers and sisters in Christ,

Since graduating from high school in 2024, I have been pursuing a career as an EMT. I have enjoyed my time working and continuing to learn in the medical field; however, I have still felt a deep burden and call on my life for missionary work. God has brought an incredible opportunity for me to grow in discipleship and missions over the 2025/2026 school year through a ministry program of the International Conference on Missions called EnterMission.



Based in Knoxville, TN, and located near Johnson University, EnterMission consists of two semesters.

The fisst, beginning in early September, is on campus, focusing on classroom work in discipleship and missions. The second, A semester abroad, where I will continue to grow my knowledge and experience in the mission field. I will dedicate 10 months of my life to learning how to be the hands and feet of Jesus in both local settings and overseas. EnterMission will provide me with the most up-to-date training in discipleship, which requires time, energy, and a willingness to be molded as I live and work in community. Structured in a trade-school fashion, this program will provide me with a hands-on approach to ministry formation, equipping me for whatever God calls me to in the mission field.
